As the mover of the original motion, I present the results of the vote for the awarding of the hosting rights for the 2011 Crew Meeting of the Canada JCI Senate.

There were 830 E-Mails sent out to members by Senator Barney C Ziola. There are 217 Canadian Senators who we cannot contact by E-Mail.

The E-Mail clearly stated that a response was required by December 15th, either granting the Executive the power normally vested in General Assembly attendees to decide on the hosting of the Annual Crew Meeting for 2011 or not approving this transfer of power.

The replies are now in...131 E-Mail responses were received. 8 of these were rejected E-Mails as the recipients' mailbox was not accepting any incoming mail for one reason or another; 123 E-Mails voted YES granting the approval. Not one single E-Mail was received voting to not grant the approval.

The 123 E-Mails were from a variety of locations, as follows: Ontario 48; British Columbia 37; Manitoba 12; Alberta 10; Quebec 4; Nova Scotia 3; Saskatchewan 2; New Brunswick 2; PEI 1; Canadian Senators in the US 3; Canadian Senator in the Philippines 1.

Some Senators may wonder why we selected this unusual method. Our only thought was to give the majority of members of the Canada JCI Senate the best possible Crew Meeting. No other location west of the Manitoba/Ontario border had indicated interest in being the host city and a check with other possible sites resulted in no apparent desire to host a Crew Meeting at this time.

The interest and excitement displayed by a very competent group of 19 Senators in Victoria under the leadership of Chairman Senator Eric Charman 4216 and Secretary Treasurer Brian J Small 6444 gave their full support concerning the bid. The facilities and events available, if a decision could be made immediately left little doubt that we had to accept this

offer. This decision was reached after a discussion between the four members of your Executive and all 4 members were strongly in favour. We were, however, not prepared to assume that all would support our decision hence the E-Mail vote.

Prior to the final decision being made our Secretary Treasurer Barney C Ziola and his wife Molly visited with the hosting committee in Victoria for an onsite inspection. They were convinced that this was the ideal setting for our 2011 Crew Meeting and that the host committee was more than capable of organizing a Crew Meeting to remember. Barney has attended every Crew Meeting since the first one in 1975, so who better to make this recommendation.

We want to thank those Senators who took the time to respond to the vote and who supported our decision with a 100% support. It is appreciated.

Dear Barney – Some weeks ago we talked about the good old Jaycee days and today I am going to start and do my best to tell you my stories.

I started my Jaycee life in Fort William, Ontario (now called Thunder Bay which includes Port Arthur) after coming to Canada as an Immigrant from Germany in February 1952. After a tough few years I started working in the Real Estate profession, must have joined Jaycees in 1955. In 1958 Senator Leo McKenna 83, a great Jaycee and Senator from Montreal presented Senatorship 1472 to me on February 28, 1958. Being active in the community, I initiated many projects in 1960 and I was elected President.

Among the many projects, we promoted winter employment, employer-employee relations seminars and in 1961 we sold over 1000 brooms to finance some of our projects at the same time promoting "Get out the Vote" campaign. We sent up balloons during Jaycee Week at the all Ontario Jaycee Convention in 1968 held in Fort William/Port Arthur when I met Senator Gordon A. Wiley 10494 who has been a great friend when I really needed one. And that is what Jaycees are all about. Anyone who knows Gordon please give him a telephone call at 416-232-9188.

I was a Good Will Ambassador on a trip to London, England plus Edinburgh, Scotland and talked about Canada and my life. I also promoted Good Will visits with Minneapolis, Duluth Jaycees. On one of our visits the City of Fort William gave us a live Beaver and when we tried to place him in a glass cage, a parks employee was bitten in the knee and needed hospital care. At the US border we were not allowed to bring a live animal into the country. I called the Office of the Minnesota Senator Hubert Humphrey and was granted permission to present the Beaver to the Duluth Jaycees.

Barney – I started this letter after we talked some days ago, but have been very busy with many other activities. Attached is information about my bid for President of the Minnesota Jaycees, but the vote was not enough. During the campaign I had great support from Ford Motor and others. St Paul Jaycees had a 100 piece Boys Scouts Band playing for Meyer and one of our friends had an armed vehicle for me. It was a great show and I learned a lot about people. Remember Winston Churchill said even in defeat there is victory.

After the election I joined Texaco as a Real Estate Agent in Iowa and Nebraska and served some years as Assistant Supervisor with the Bank of Nova Scotia

Because of the breakup of our family I was not happy in Toronto. Found a great job as the Building Manager at the IBM building in Houston, Texas for 18 years until 1998 when I retired. I am still very active in University Rotary Club although they made me an honorary member after 36 years of perfect attendance. I have been a member and President of the Executive Association of Huston for 26 years with a membership of 100. I also have served with several community associations.

I have enclosed three newspaper articles that were published - they are titled "Jaycees Entertain Visitors", "Appoint Fred Meyer Senator in Jaycees" and "Jaycees Hold International Jaycee Dinner and Dance" Event – with attendees from Duluth, Fort William and Port Arthur.

I want to thank Molly and Barney for their kindness during the past years plus all the Jaycees that supported me in the past. My wife Hedda and I wish you all the best for the future.
