I then began moving up the Regional and National level, being elected Secretary Treasurer of the Central Region Jaycees in 1992. Also serving as Regional Awards Chairman for Central Region and National Awards Chairman for the Canadian Junior Chamber in 1991, 92 and 93. I was elected Vice President – Central Region in 1993. And elected as Central Region President/National Vice President – Canada Jaycees in 1994.

I was awarded Central Regions' Most Outstanding Executive Member in 1993.

I was awarded Most Outstanding Jaycee in Oshawa, Central Region, and the Canadian Junior Chamber in 1994.

I was awarded Most Outstanding National Vice President – Canadian Junior Chamber in 1994.

Then, the pinnacle of my Jaycee Career, being awarded a Junior Chamber International Senatorship in May of 1995. Senator #54515.

I was then awarded Most Outstanding Senator of the Year, for both the Central Region Jaycees and the Canadian Junior Chamber in 1996.

After a few years rest, and out of the lime-light, I was elected Secretary/Treasurer of the Durham Senate in 2012 and again in 2013

I was then elected as President of the Durham Senate in 2014 and again in 2015. Then serving as Past President in 2016 and 2017.

Throughout the late 1990's and the early 2000's I served on numerous Durham Senate committees, most notably our annual Durham Senate Golf Tournament and BBQ. I also attended the odd conferences and conventions. And even managed to attend a few Amerada's.
